September 4 ~ December 20

### Winter 2025

January 6 ~ April 16

Nomination Deadline: October 15, 2024

Application Deadline: November 1, 2024

Standard credit load (per semester) Recommended: 4 courses (12 credit hours)

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT

Exchange students are required to submit an official language certificate, and we ask our partners to ensure students have one of the following before submitting the nomination:

- IELTS: minimum of 5.5 with no bands less than 5.5
- iBT TOEFL: minimum of 70
- Cambridge English: B2
- Duolingo: minimum score of 100
